



St Adelwold's Church, Alvingham

Passed the mill house, through the farmyard, next to the canal we find St Adelwold's. Serving the villages of Alvingham, North Cockerington and Yarburgh, this church was formerly part of the Gilbertine priory which occupied this site.

Rather unusually St Adelwold's occupies the same churchyard as St Mary's, the former parish church of North Cockerington. (St Mary's is now under the care of the Church Conservation Trust.)

We are delighted that the children of North Cockerington School regularly worship in the church and Puddleducks, the nearby nursery, often explore the churchyard.

We have a service of Holy Communion on the first Sunday of each month and share worship with the Methodist chapel on the second Sunday. For more details see our newsheet.

Our Millennium bench, on the edge of the churchyard, overlooking the canal, offers a perfect place to sit, relax, and breathe the fresh air.
